01 TV

The Amazon Fire TV is set up with Netflix and Disney+ under our account. Contact us if you need a password. The adult profile code is 8888

02 AC/HEAT

Central air conditioning and heating are controlled by the thermostat in the living room, towards the bathroom. Please keep windows closed while the air conditioning is running.

03 TRASH

Large bins are outside. Black is garbage. Blue is recycling.

04 BARBECUE

The barbecue is electric and infra-red, so coals and lighter are not needed. Please ensure the barbecue is cleaned after each use.

05 FIRE PIT

Please keep fires to a reasonable size: flames shouldn't be much higher than the enclosure.

Wood is the only item permitted to be burned in the firepit. Starters are in drawer by deck door.

Please keep chairs at a reasonable distance to avoid sparks landing.

06 DECK CHAIRS

Cushions can be found in the grey box. Please return them there after use so they stay dry. To fold deck chairs, lift the back. To lie back, lift the arms.

KITCHEN

01

COFFEE & TEA

You'll find a Keurig machine, kettle and French press in the kitchen. K-Cups and teabags are in the cupboard.

02

DISHWASHER

You'll find dishwasher pods under the sink. Running the dishwasher upon your departure is appreciated.

03

STOVE

The induction stove only functions with a pot or pan on the burner. We love that little hands are less likely to get burned and spills are extra easy to clean.

04

BREVILLE COMBI WAVE

This microwave/convection oven/air fryer has a round non-stick crisp pan and grill (see drawer), and the machine should inform you when you need to use one of these.

05

POTS & PANS

We have lots of pots and pans in the bottom cabinet left of the stove.

06

KNIVES

There is a drawer of sharps (knives and scissors) to the right of the stove. Everything is intended for our guests to use.



the LAUNDRY

01 WASHING MACHINE

Do not overfill the washer. Place wet clothes in the dryer as soon as possible to avoid mildew buildup. Shake all sand from towels and clothing outside before placing in the washer.

02 DRYER

We like that the dryer has a steam function if you need to quickly remove wrinkles.

03 DRYING RACK

There is a drying rack in the laundry space that is helpful for drying beach towels and swimsuits.

04 LINENS

Please reach out to Lakeside Property Management if you need assistance with linens.

05 TOWELS

We supply bath towels for each guest, and beach towels are available on the shelf outside the bathroom. Please do not take bath towels to the beach.

HAIR DRYER

A hair dryer can be found in the baskets on the shelf outside the bathroom.

TOWELS

You will find a bath towel for each guest. These towels are not to be used at the beach.

MAKEUP CLOTHS

You will also find black cloths for removing makeup. These are provided to reduce wear on the white cloths and towels.

BELONGINGS

Ensure you have all your personal belongings before you leave.

02

TRASH

Garbage/recycling collection is Tuesday. If your stay includes Tuesday morning, please move the big bins a few feet to the road (Morenz Lane) by 7 a.m.

LINENS & TOWELS

Please strip beds and leave used linens and towels in the laundry area.

KITCHEN

Please run the dishwasher with the pods we've provided, and check that the stove is off.

POWER

Please check that all lights and electronic devices are off.
